BOTTOM LINE

Talk About It

Kids: How do you think Jesus' parents would have celebrated His birthdays long ago?

Parents: Brainstorm ideas to celebrate Jesus' "birth" day with your family.

December 9, 2018

Christmas Story: Good News - Luke 2:8-18

BOTTOM LINE

Tell others the good news of Jesus' birth.

Talk About It

Kids: What was the good news the angels told the shepherds?

Parents: Share with your child some "good news" from your day.

December 16, 2018

An Amazing Star: The Story of the Wise Men - Matthew 2:1-12

BOTTOM LINE

Wise men follow the star to baby Jesus.

Talk About It

Kids: What gifts did the Wise Men bring to Jesus?

Parents: Ask your child what gift they would give to Jesus. What would your gift be?

December 30, 2018

Waiting, Waiting: The Story of Simeon & Anna - Luke 2:21-38

BOTTOM LINE

God teaches us that we need to learn to wait.

Talk About It

Kids: Is it hard for you to wait for happy things?

Parents: It's often very hard for little ones to wait patiently. Make up a silly tune about waiting patiently; count backwards to measure time.

Each day, spend some time practicing Faith@Home with your child.

Talk about the questions at the dinner table or in the car.

Praying that this helps you pass your faith on to your kids.
