# Conversations with the Creator



Ephesians 3:7, 9-10, 14-21

1. If you were a super hero which one would you be and why? Do you have an all-time favourite super hero movie?
2. If you could pray for only one thing these days, what would it be and why?
3. Read over Ephesians 3:14-19. In light of this mystery now revealed of all being included in Christ (both insiders - Jews, and outsiders - Gentiles), what is Paul's one prayer? Why do you think he prays this?
4. What part of Paul's prayer hits you the most? That God may strengthen you in your inner being? That you, being rooted and establishing in love, may have power to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ? Or that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God?
5. How would Paul's one prayer compare to what you would pray for in question 2? Usually my prayers are way too little in light of Paul's. What would it look like for everyone around you to be strengthened in their inner being, rooted and established in love, grasping the full four dimensional love of God, and being filled with all God's fullness?
6. With that in mind, as a benediction, pray Ephesians 3:20-21 out loud together like you mean it. Be encouraged to pray this as part of your 15 minutes of prayer a day!
