Why read the bible?

- Give guidance for everyday living. (2 Tim 3:16; Psalm 119:105)
- Gives us a knowledge of who God is (Psalm 27:1; Isaiah 9:6)
- Gives us a deeper love for Jesus (Luke 7:47)
- Makes us aware of our own need for God’s grace (Psalm 51:10)
- Gives us a knowledge of God’s plan (Ephesians 2:8,10)
- Provides personal transformation (Galatians 2:20)
- Empowers us to witness (Philippians 3:10)
- Gives us protection against the enemy (James 4:7)
- Teaches us how to pray (Psalm 119:11)

Reflection Questions

1. Is there something that consistently is a distraction or obstacle that keeps you from reading the bible?
2. How can you make changes to your schedule that prioritize scripture reading?
3. What does your current schedule reveal about your priorities?
4. What part of studying scripture do you struggle with most?
5. What is something that God’s Word has revealed about you? How are you responding to that revelation?
